

# Enka-fill Back Alpine Rally

**AUSTRALIA'S MOST TRADITIONAL motor sporting event, the Light Car Club of Australia's Alpine Rally will be held on the weekend of November 24-25, as the final round of the 1984 Australian Rally Championship.**

Enjoying major sponsorship from Enka-fill, Australia's leading car cloth supplier, the Enka-fill Alpine will be held in the superb mountain country surrounding the resort township of Bright, in north-eastern Victoria. Rally drivers and spectators alike acclaim this area as the best rally territory in Australia.

The start of the 1984 Enka-fill Alpine will be televised in Melbourne on Friday, November 23, although the competitive action will not commence until Saturday morning, when the first special stage will be held on the Bright Speedway, in the heart of town.

The Enka-fill Alpine will see the conclusion of an exciting contest for the Australian Rally Championship. Three crews — Ed Mulligan/Geoff Jones (Mazda), David 'Dinta' Officer/Kate Hobson (Galant) and Greg Carr/Fred Gocentas (Fiat 131) are possible winners of this title, so the action should be fast and frantic all weekend. Ninety crews, including top competitors from almost every State of Australia, are expected to compete.

Always one of the most popular events on the rally calendar, the 1984 Enka-fill Alpine will continue the sixty year old tradition of the event in a fitting manner. Intending spectators are assured of great rally action, in superb mountain surroundings, on the weekend of November 24/25.
