1. CHANGES TO COMPETITOR ROADBOOKS

During pre-event route inspections it was noted that several hazards had changed. Please update your Roadbooks as follows:

DIVISION 1, SS1 WEST BOUNDARY

Tulip 14 at 8.13 km is now a CAUTION.

- Change the instruction to “RGHL, CAUTION, tree and hole on inside – stay out”
- Add a hole to the tulip, immediately to the L of the tree.
- Add an exclamation mark to the tulip and in the information column to show it as a CAUTION

DIVISION 1, TP2 Reformatory to Berkley Square

Tulip 7 at 13.17 km is now a CARE due to a gutter at the TL.

- Change the instruction to “CARE TL gutter, then 20m KR on MR”
- In the tulip, add a gutter across the approach road, parallel to the MR you’re turning left onto.
- Add an exclamation mark to the tulip and in the information column to show it as a CARE

DIVISION 6, TP12B Ensay to Nunniong

Extra information for Tulip 5 at 8.06 km

A 40 kph sign has been added 100m before this bridge and a Give Way sign has been posted on the bridge.

- Add “40 kph, Give Way” to the instruction.

DIVISION 6, SS14 NUNNIONG

Extra information for Tulip 8 at 12.45 km.

- Add “Rough for 300m” to this instruction.

DIVISION 6, TP15 Splitters Ridge to Lake Omeo

Additional advice: McKenzies Rd, from the start of this transport to 5.62 km, has been badly damaged by rain – take care.

Tulip 2 at 1.95 is now a CAUTION

- Add two exclamation marks to the tulip and in the information column to show it as a CAUTION.
- Change the instruction to “CAUTION through Gateway – deep gutter LHS. SLOW.”

DIVISION 8, SS23 MOONLIGHT

Tulip 14 at 18.11 is now an EXTREME CAUTION

- Add an exclamation mark to the tulip and in the information column to show it as an EXTREME CAUTION.
- Change to instruction to “EXTREME CAUTION RGL then deep gutter then deep ruts on RHS for 100m”

DIVISION 9, SS24 ASH RANGE

Additional Advice: Ash Range Road has fared badly in recent rains – it is generally rougher and rockier and care is needed.

Tulip 7 at 7.74 is now a CAUTION

- Add an exclamation mark to the tulip and in the information column to show it as a CAUTION.
- Change to instruction to “CAUTION Rocky downhill”

2. CHANGE TO SERVICE INSTRUCTIONS
