1. OFFICIALS

Motorsport Australia has appointed the following officials:

2. PROTEST AGAINST COURSE

A protest against any mistake, irregularity or action to the prejudice of the event occurring, or becoming apparent while the competition is taking place, must be lodged:

(i) in writing within two hours of a crew booking-in at the end of the day in which the alleged mistake, irregularity or action occurred, or

(ii) if a written Competitor Enquiry lodged with the Organisers is not answered until a later time, a protest must be lodged within two hours of a crew booking-in at the end of the day on which the Organisers provide the answer.

3. UPDATE OF RESTRICTED SPEED ZONE PENALTIES

Article 17 in Further regulations should read:

Restricted Speed Zones (RSZs) will be used in area of dangerous road conditions as a safety measure. At a Restricted Speed Zone, competitors will be required to slow down to 40 kph within the signed RSZ. On approaching the RSZ, there will be 300m, 200m and 100m warning boards. At the start of the RSZ there will be "RSZ START" boards on both sides of the road and at the end of the zone there will be "RSZ END" boards. Between the RSZ START and RSZ END boards you need to decrease your speed to 40 kph or below for the entire distance of the RSZ.

- The RallySafe system will be used to determine the speed of the vehicle.
- The RallySafe system will show the distance to the end of the zone.
- Overtaking is not permitted within the Restricted Speed Zone.
- Vehicles must not impede another Competitor.

The following penalties will apply for actions within a Restricted Speed Zone:

Restricted Speed Zone (RSZ): Competitors must not exceed a specified speed limit for a specified length of road. Signs must be used to indicate the start and finish of the RSZ. Average speed may be measured by Motorsport Australia approved radar speed measuring device, GPS tracking device in the car, or by recording time of entry to and exit from the RSZ. Penalties are:

- (A) Exceeding specified maximum speed by up to 5 km/h - 1second per second gained.
- (B) Exceeding specified maximum speed by 5 to 10 km/h – 2 seconds per second gained.
- (C) Exceeding specified maximum speed by more than 10 km/h – 5 seconds per second gained.
